## GENERAL INFORMATION:

The talent contest will be organized in three (3) categories. Preteen (ages 4-12), teen (ages 13-17), and adult (ages 18 and up). Prizes in all categories will be: First Place - \$100.00, Second Place - \$50.00, and Third Place - \$25.00. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place contestants in each category will perform on Sunday at the Flatlanders Picnic in the Park. All awards will be handed out Sunday after the performances.

**Application deadline is September 15, 2009.** All applications must be accompanied by the ENTRY FEE of \$25.00 and can be mailed to the address listed below or returned in person. One entry fee will cover an individual as well as a group AND IS NON-REFUNDABLE. We reserve the right to restrict the type of talent presented. A schedule of performance times will be forwarded to contestants by **September 21st**.

Each contestant has 15 minutes total performance time. Set up time is pre-set at time of performance by the stage director. All pre-recorded music must be submitted in CD format not to exceed 15 minutes with all music on one CD in chronological order of performance.

Performance schedule changes will be determined prior to the day of the contest by the performance director and will go as follows; pre-teen, teen, and adult. Each contestant will be judged by a panel of judges. ALL JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL. All prizes will be awarded on Sunday at the picnic in the park performance. All first, second and third place winners will then participate in the performance Sunday as required by these rules.

Public address system, electric piano, microphones, amplifiers, and stage will be provided. Contestants will be responsible for supplying any other instrument or equipment they will need for the performance.
